What is VMT per Household (VMT / HH)?

- The total miles travelled by all vehicles operated by a household on a typical day.
- Estimated as an average for households living in Pasadena "zones" (Census Tracts).

What does VMT / HH look like in Pasadena?



Estimated VMT / HH in Pasadena zones

- Low VMT per HH (Less than 30 vehicle-miles per day)
- Medium VMT per HH (30 to 45 vehicle-miles per day)
- High VMT per HH (Greater than 45 vehicle-miles per day)
- Estimated Pasadena Average

Why does VMT matter?

- Lower VMT / HH indicates less vehicle travel which results in...
- Less congestion
- Less air pollution
- Fewer greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions
