# 1. Update on MWD Pipeline Shutdown Preparations:

In preparation for the imported water pipeline shutdown from February 21-28, Pasadena Water and Power (PWP) has been filling local reservoirs in anticipation of the shutdown. Also, PWP has been working with neighboring water utilities to arrange for possible additional water supplies during the shutdown.

A joint press conference has been scheduled at City Hall on Tuesday, February 19<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. Speakers will include Phyllis Currie, General Manager, Water and Power, representatives from the Metropolitan Water District (MWD) and the Foothill Water District, and Nancy Long from PWP.

PWP has ordered 50 yard signs (see attached) reminding customers to conserve water. These are being distributed around the city at various high-traffic and high-visibility areas such as at City Hall, and various community leaders and other citizens have volunteered to display these at their homes and businesses.

According to Phyllis Currie, PWP staff has contacted the 200 top water users plus an additional 500 business customers, all City Community Centers, and various non-profit agencies. PWP has also used Neighborhood Connections to remind residential customers to conserve water during the shutdown.
